Number of Participants

The Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry allows eligible Veterans and Servicemembers to document their exposure to airborne hazards such as burn pit smoke through an online questionnaire. In total, 164,775 Veterans and Servicemembers completed the questionnaire since the start of the registry in June 2014 through the 1st Quarter of Fiscal Year 2019 (December 31, 2018).
