

# The Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry

## Number of Participants

The Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry allows eligible Veterans and service members to document their exposure to airborne hazards such as burn pit smoke through an online questionnaire. In total, 209,097 Veterans and Servicemembers completed the questionnaire since the start of the registry in June 2014 through the 3rd Quarter of Fiscal Year 2020 (June 30, 2020).
